



Installation Process

Installing JSAS 6.0 requires different procedure depending on whether it is a first-time installation or upgrading from a prior version. When upgrading there are different steps to follow depending on what version of JSAS you have since some schools have JSAS version 5.0 or an earlier version of JSAS 6.0.

First-time Installation – No prior version of the Jamaica School Administrative System (JSAS) software has been installed. There are two situations to be considered:

- A. STAND-ALONE
- B. NETWORK

Stand-Alone

Insert CD labeled “JSAS 6.0 Install CD”

Installation and Setup – First-Time Installation

Installation must be within a Window’s Operating System environment. It is recommended to install on computers with operating system - Windows Me, Windows Windows 2000 or later

Starting the Installation Wizard

While in a Window’s environment, insert the *JSAS-Version 6.0* compact disc (CD) into the computer’s CD drive. Next follow the steps in **Chapter 1 – Installation and Setup of the JSAS 6.0 Installation and Setup Manual**

After installing the software, copy the backend that is the file labeled *JSAS6.0_be.mdb* from the CD to the folder labeled *C:/Program Files/MOEC2000* using the steps below

Copying JSAS6.0_be.mdb

1. Open Windows Explorer, click Start, then Programs, then Accessories and then Windows Explorer.
2. To the left of the Windows Explorer window select the drive labeled JSASInstallCD
3. To the right of the window select the file labeled JSAS6.0_be.mdb
4. Click on Edit, then Copy
5. To the left of the window, click of the +sign beside the C drive
6. Click on the +sign beside Program Files folder
7. Then select the MOEC 2000 folder
8. Click on Edit, then Paste

After installation refer to **Chapter 2 – Customising JSAS in the- JSAS 6.0 Installation and Setup Manual** as to how to customise and use the software.

Networking Environment

In a networking environment one machine must be the “server” and the others the “client machines”.

All the files are installed on the server, but the backend (*JSAS60_be.mdb*) should not be installed on the client machines.

1. You must install on the server first, using the same procedures listed above for stand-alone and copy the backend (*JSAS60_be.mdb*).
2. After installation on the server then install on the client machines.
3. To install on the client machines follow the same procedures listed above for stand-alone installation process above excluding copying the backend (*JSAS60_be.mdb*).

Re-link to Backend (*JSAS60_be.mdb*)

1. After installing on the client machines, there will be a need to re-link to the server to work with the backend. That is you will need to point the client machines to the *JSAS60_be.mdb* on the server.
2. To do this follow instructions in the JSAS 6.0 Installation and Setup Manuals – Chapter 2 – Customising .JSAS - page 33 through to page 35

Upgrading from JSAS version 5.0

1. When upgrading from a JSAS version 5.0, the installation process is the same as stated above for Stand Alone
2. After you have copied the backend that is *JSAS60_be.mdb* go to the *C:/Program Files/MOEC2000* and open the *Maintenance_6_0.mdb*
3. Run the maintenance module to update tables from the prior version to JSAS version 6.0
4. After running the maintenance module open the *UpdateTestData60.mdb* and run this module as well.

After updating all these module you should go straight into Customising JSAS- Chapter 2 of the JSAS 6.0 Installation and Setup Manual, the same will apply whether it is in a networking or a stand alone environment.

Upgrading from JSAS version 6.0

1. When upgrading from an earlier version of JSAS version 6.0, the installation process is the same as stated above for Stand Alone.
2. After you have copied the backend that is *JSAS60_be.mdb*
3. Go straight into Customising JSAS- Chapter 2 of the JSAS 6.0 Installation and Setup Manual, the same will apply whether it is in a networking or a stand alone environment.
